
Why Lim-Flex?

FLEXIBILITY

Lim-Flex bulls provide a number of options for breeders with straight bred Angus herds. Using a Lim-Flex 50 bull (50% Limousin and 50% Angus) produces calves that are 75% Angus, 25% Limousin. The resulting calf drop will have extra muscle and shape, whilst maintaining the marketability, with the 75% Angus black steers being accepted into most "Angus" markets including Certified Australian Angus Beef. The 75% Angus heifer replacements will be easy calving, efficient, easy maintenance cows with plenty of milk and longevity with some hybrid vigour. They can be flexible in their matings, with options to join back to Angus, Lim-Flex 50 to increase muscling, or Lim-Flex25 to stabilise the 75/25 Angus/Limousin cross.

An alternative is to use a Pure Limousin bull over Angus Females to produce 50% Limousin 50% Angus calves. Both the heifer and steer progeny are highly sought after by lot feeders supplying the domestic market including the supermarkets or for taking out to heavier weights. If the 50% Angus females are retained they can be mated to Lim-Flex 50 bulls to stabilise the herd at 50/50 Angus/Limousin.
